Pensioner concessions are available from kiosks between 9.00 am and 5.00 pm.

HOW TO ENTER MONORAIL SYSTEM

Entry to the system is via turnstiles which are activated by tokens and \$2 coins or via turnstiles with card readers fitted which are activated by Monorail Cards.

Tokens are obtained from token vending machines (TVM) installed at each Monorail Station.

TOKEN VENDING MACHINE OPERATION

Operating instructions are displayed on each TVM. TVM's will accept most Australian \$ Notes and will also provide change.

TURNSTILE OPERATION

1. Insert token or \$2 coin in slot at the front of turnstile.
2. Proceed through turnstile.



MONORAIL TOKEN

For the souvenir or coin collector, proof packs of Monorail Tokens are available from Station Kiosks.

OPERATING HOURS

Please refer to signs at stations for current operating hours.

MONORAIL CARD

For the regular Monorail user, a card entry system which provides the convenience of discounts and quick access to the system is available.

Monorail cards are available from Station Kiosks and dispensing machines at selected stations. Dispensing machines may also be used to add more discounted fare credits to your Monorail Card.

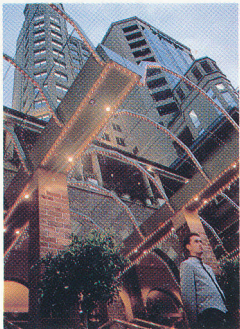

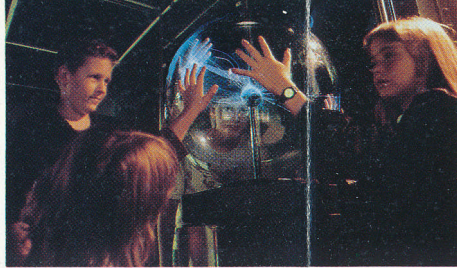

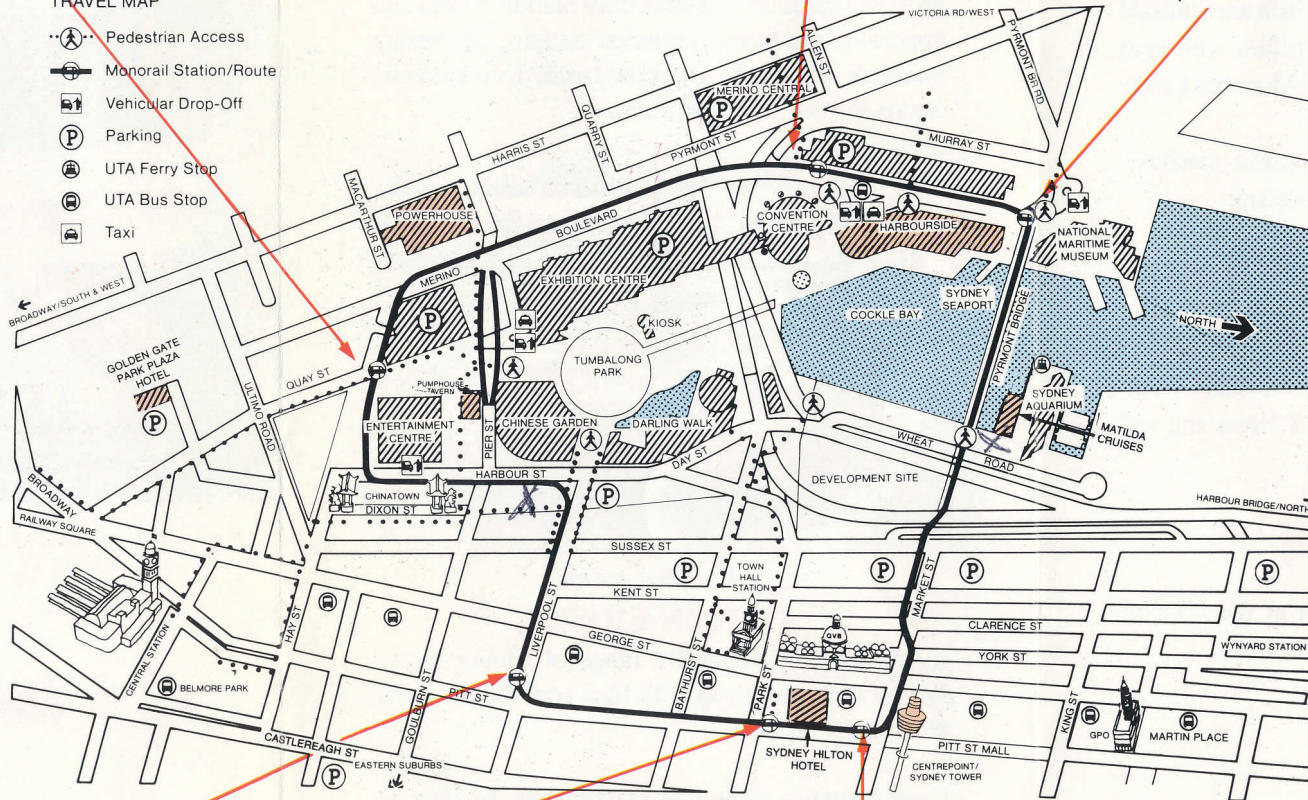
